Introduction

First of all, I would like to thank Asia Pacific Spine Society (APSS) for awarding me this fellowship under Prof Kuniyoshi Abumi. The APSS arranged the airline tickets and accommodation. Jenny Wong and the APSS have been very well organised with the schedule for the fellowship. I arrived in Sapporo on 11th March 2019. Prof Abumi was kind enough to send his personnel to receive me at the airport. He even arranged basic daily utilities including Wifi so that I would not struggle in the initial days. I stayed at Cesar Kotoni apartment in Sapporo. The room was clean and comfortable with a lot of restaurants and mini markets around. The apartment was equipped with all the basic cooking equipment. Immediately I was taken to Sapporo Orthopedic Hospital and was greeted by Prof Abumi. Following a basic introduction I was allowed to scrub in with him for the Lumbar L5-S1 TLIF case. After the case, Prof Abumi invited me for dinner. It was a pleasure interacting with him. It amazes me how a world famous surgeon is so down to earth.

Subsequently I visited hospitals all around the Hokkaido Island of Japan. Wherever there was a good spine surgery, Prof Abumi scheduled my travel to that hospital. Prof Abumi was kind enough to arrange for my travel to far away hospitals. In these 3 months I got to see a variety of surgeries, ranging from basic degenerative to scoliosis and cranio-vertebral spine surgeries. I saw a novel technique of Cortical Bone trajectory screws free hand and using 3D template. I have learnt the techniques for Laminoplasty and Cervical Pedicle screw fixation and I am confident that I can start utilising all these in my practice. Prof Abumi arranged for me to attend the JSSR 2019 in Yokohama. I interacted with great Japanese Spine surgeons and other surgeons from around the world.









2) TLIF L4-S1 with cortical bone trajectory screws with Posterior decompression L2-L4 in a case of LCS with Degenerative Scoliosis







3) T saw Laminoplasty C3-C6 in a case of OPLL with myelopathy















4) C1-C2 Subaxial instability in a case of Rheumatoid cervical Spine Preop C1-C2 and Sub-axial instability X-ray
